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### Prevention Fee Schedule

The Fire Marshal shall not authorize an inspection or re-inspection until the permittee has paid all fee(s). Fees are charged per inspection.

For your convenience, permit fees can be paid by cash, check (payable to *Lake Havasu City*), American Express, Discover, Master Card, or VISA. ### Administrative Fees or Penalties

**Permit Fees will double when work commences without first obtaining an approved permit fee(s) and having plans approved.**

# Prevention Fee Schedule

## Stand-alone Fire Permits continued...

- Operational Permit – Special Event [S-583] No Charge**
- Issuance of an operational permit, plan review, and fire safety inspection for a special event at a location not already covered by another City permit process as outlined in the International Fire Code.
- Spray Booths – New installation [S-565] \$258**
- Review plans for spray booths and new sprinkler systems for spray booths. Perform inspections to ensure compliance with approved plans.
- Temporary Membrane Air Structures, Tents & Canopies [S-571]**
- Review plans for tents and temporary membrane air supported structures. Perform inspections to ensure compliance with approved plans.
    - Tents in excess of 400 sq. ft. \$179
    - Open tents in excess of 700 sq. ft. \$179
    - Temporary membrane air-supported structures. \$179

- Inspection of Arizona State licensed adult care facilities.
    - Residential- Adult care Facility Residential per location \$63

- Home Safety & Babysitting Classes [S-580] (billed to applicant)**
- Provide children between the ages of 11-15 with home safety and babysitting training, minimum of 10 students per class. **(Fee per participant)**
    - Lake Havasu City residents No Charge
    - Non-local participants \$72.00

# Prevention Fee Schedule

## Fire Sprinkler Systems (AFSS)

**NOTE: Any modification with over 50+ heads should be treated as a new system.**

### New System Commercial/Industrial Sprinkler Systems [S-556]

- Review commercial/industrial sprinkler plans to include standpipe plans. Perform on-site inspections of sprinkler system to ensure compliance with appropriate fire code requirements. Includes pressure check of system and final acceptance test.

- Plan review, permit, and inspection of repairs or alterations to existing commercial or residential fire sprinkler systems.

- Review multi-family sprinkler plans. Perform on-site inspections of sprinkler systems to ensure compliance with appropriate code requirements.

### Non-Required Fire Sprinkler System Inspection Single Family [S-559] No Charge

- Review plans and perform on-site inspection of a sprinkler system, which is not required by code or the City to be inspected, to ensure compliance with industry standards.

### Fire Lines/ Hydrants (Check/Inspection/Repair of Underground Lines & Hydrants) [S-561]

- Review plans and perform field inspections for new construction or repair of fire lines, including private fire hydrants and fire sprinkler supply, to ensure compliance with code requirements.

# Prevention Fee Schedule

## Fire Alarm System Install / Repair

### New Fire Alarm System [S-567]

- Plan Review, permit, and inspections to ensure code compliance.
- Installation of 1 to 20 devices **\$375**
- Each device over 20 **\$6.25 each**

### Existing Fire Alarm System [S-567]

- Plan Review, permit, and inspections of repairs or alterations to ensure code compliance.
- Major Modification (Replacement of alarm control unit for upgrade or alteration or the change out or addition of 5 or more devices) **\$250**
- Minor Modification (Replacement of less than 5 devices due to upgrade or alteration) **\$125**
- Repair/removal tracking (Tracking purpose only: replacement of power supply; work not qualified as a major alteration, repair of less than 5 devices such as smoke, heat, pull stations, etc.) **\$50**

## Engineered Extinguishing System for Fire Protection

### Clean Agent System, Halon, or Alternative Systems [S-564]

- Review plans for a new engineered fire protection extinguishing system. Inspect to ensure compliance with approved plans.
- Standard (hood systems, duct systems, etc.) Halon or Alternate Systems **\$258**
- Major Modification (addition of appliances requiring additional agent, piping or hood replacement or upgrade to UL300 system) **\$258**
- Minor Modification (Relocation of appliances not requiring additional piping or agent) **\$258**
- Repairs (tracking purpose only: replacement of lines, links, or recharge from fire activation or accidental discharge, replacement of sensors, links, or actuation device due to neglect or lack of service or other alerting devices.) **\$52**

## Fuel Tanks

### Underground Fuel Tank, Chemical Tank, or Oil Tank [S-572]

- Underground fuel/chemical tank installation **\$460**
- Standby at removal of underground fuel/chemical tanks **\$378**

### Aboveground Permanent Fuel Tank, Chemical Tank, or Oil Tank [S-572]

- Installation of Temporary Aboveground fuel tank **\$126**
- Installation of Fixed Generator sub-tank **\$126**
- Installation of Permanent Aboveground fuel tank **\$460**

# Prevention Fee Schedule

## Hazardous Materials

### Hazardous Materials Incidents, Investigations [S-552] (billed to property/business owner)

- Respond to chemical or other hazardous materials spills and/or cleaning up potential hazards inside/outside city limits.
  - Pipeline hazardous material incidents occurring while following 811 (Blue Stake) guidelines **No Charge**
  - Full- service hazardous materials incident (staff, materials, equipment) **Fully burdened staff hourly rates, supplies, equipment**
  - Additional charge for reimbursement of HAZMAT supplies **Replacement cost**

### Operational Permit for Hazardous Materials [S-582]

**No Charge**

- Issuance of an operational permit, plan review, and fire safety inspection to store or use hazardous materials as outlined in the International Fire Code.

## Emergency Fire/Medical Services (billed to patient/guardian)

### Repeated Use of Emergency Services [S-550] (billed to property/business owner)

- Fee for repeated non-emergency use of emergency services (per month)
  - 1 – 9 Calls **No Charge**
  - 10+ Calls **Actual Cost using burdened rates**

### Fire False Alarm Response [S-551] (billed to property/business owner)

- Respond to fire false alarms and faulty fire systems. (per calendar year)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> – 2<sup>nd</sup> false alarms per year **No Charge**
  - 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> false alarms per year **\$164 each**
  - 6<sup>th</sup>+ false alarms per year **\$205 each**

### Technical Team Rescue Outside City Limits [S-553]

**Fully burdened hourly rates**

- Where patient(s) is/are extricated from a situation, including but not limited to: desert, trench, confined space, high angle, and swift water rescues.

### Emergency Fire/Medical Services Outside City Limits [S-553]

**Fully burdened hourly rates**

### Motor Vehicle Accident Outside City Limits[S-553]

- Where patient treatment was performed, or mitigation of some type from the FD was necessary. **Fully burdened hourly rates**

### Additional Charge for reimbursement of ARFF supplies [S-553]

**Replacement Cost**
